God is doing an astounding work in a region of the world that has been historically closed to the gospel. Pray for the light of God's Word to shine on the dominantly Muslim culture. Boldly ask God for salvation in the name of Jesus Christ to be proclaimed through the daily broadcast—available online, on television, and on the radio throughout the region.

- The first Kurdish Thru the Bible program went on the air this year in Kurdistan with a potential audience of 1.5 to 2.5 million listeners. Pray and celebrate that now both Kurdish and Arabic-speaking citizens of Kurdistan can hear the Word of God—each in their own heart language
- Each weeknight, Thru the Bible-Persian is part of a 90-minute primetime block of Christian broadcasts to Iran. Pray for the effectiveness of this powerful shortwave transmitter, a great source of communication from outside the country.



- Pray for online ministry possibilities, specifically in Russia.








